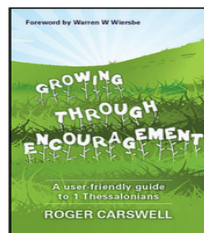

Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the dessert - Isaiah 43:19

That was the declarative word spoken by God to His people in Isaiah 43. He spoke a path created through faith, out of the seventy-year captivity into liberation and redemption. God was calling His people out from the old and into the new.

Behold means to stare in awe and be amazed. God said this as His announcement was a statement on character - our Redeemer. Furthermore, in the same breath, God was also announcing hope for humanity through Jesus Christ, and the grace of the Gospel.
